SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION: Playworks Education Contract

Purpose: Professional Development

Amount of Contract: \$39,000

Description/Scope of Services: Playworks TeamUp Program provides school staff with comprehensive on-site consulting and support in useful techniques to maintain healthy playtime. An experienced Playworks coordinator spends a week each month at each school leading, supporting, and empowering the recess team to create a safe, inclusive playground for all students.
